COMMISSIONER’S RULING

Petitioner Amber F. Kim asks the court to “consider her Personal Restraint Petition (“PRP”) on an expediated [sic] basis pursuant to RAP 17.4(b).”

RAP 17.4(b) allows a person, in an emergency, to request expedited consideration of a *motion*. A personal restraint petition is not a motion. Therefore, RAP 17.4(b) does not apply. To the extent Petitioner Kim seeks expedited – or accelerated – review of the Kim’s PRP, RAP 18.12 governs. That rule provides that a party may request accelerated disposition of any review proceeding. Because Petitioner Kim has been housed in the Intensive Management Unit at the Monroe Correctional Complex since June 21, 2024, the motion is granted.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, Petitioner Kim’s PRP will be set for accelerated disposition. RAP 18.12.
