Ms. Turner will perform a portion of her critically acclaimed one-woman show, Red Hot Patriot: The Kick-Ass Wit of Molly Ivins.

Information for Table Captains

Thank you for agreeing to serve as a Table Captain for the ACLU of Washington's Annual Bill of Rights Dinner on November 9th, 2013. Table Captains are essential to the success of our event, serving as a bridge between our mission and the community. Here are some basic instructions for recruiting, registering and hosting your guests. **We look forward to celebrating with you!**

Tips for Recruiting Guests:

1. Identify Potential Guests

Brainstorm and make a list of 12-15 potential guests. Consider friends, family, associates and colleagues who may be interested in supporting the ACLU of Washington. Remember that you'll probably need to invite more than 9 people to fill your table of 10, as not everyone will be able to attend. If all your guests say "yes," we can arrange for seats at another table. If you are unable to fill your table, we will fill it to make a table of 10.

2. Invite Your Guests!

Plan on contacting your guests again via phone or e-mail a few days before the dinner to let them know you look forward to seeing them at the event. In order to make sure they enjoy the complimentary wine reception and have time to get seated and settled, be sure to ask them to arrive on time.

Table captains will be able to buy their tables for their guests beginning on **Monday, September 9th, 2013.** We ask that all table captains maintain their own guest list and submit them to the ACLU of Washington. In order for us to create name tags, accommodate meal requests, and appropriately thank your guests, we will need you to submit your final guest list to us no later than **Friday, October 11th, 2013.**

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Greet Guests

As the host of your table, we ask that table captains get to the Marriott Hotel by 5:00 pm and greet your guests as they arrive.
